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## Evaluation – contrôle continu

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## La présentation orale

- **Sujet de votre oral** Qui? Où? Quoi? Comment? Quand?
- **Focus on the issue (problem)**
- Give your point of view.
- Give your **PRECISE REFERENCES**, the ones used in the development of your presentation.

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## Oral presentation

- **Speak clearly and slowly** from notes – **do not read a written text**
- **Format** – PowerPoint. Don't put too much information on the slides (titles, vocabulary, photos, short videos) they are to help you present the talk and for the other students to follow you. **You must not only read your slides.**

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## La présentation orale

- **Evaluation** – a) content quality and presentation plan, b) quality of your English (grammar, pronunciation, vocabulary), c) quality of communication.
- **Preparation** – research specialist vocabulary, you should present a list of key words (English –French) at the beginning of your talk to help the other students. Check your pronunciation and spelling, use online dictionaries (monolingual and bilingual) e.g. Oxford learner's dictionary <http://www.oxfordlearnersdictionaries.com>

- [Google Translate](#) for pronunciation NOT translation!

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## La présentation orale

- **Questions/ group participation** – ask the group 5 questions about your talk. Also check they have remembered the vocabulary you presented at the beginning.
- **Documentation** – work directly in English, don't translate from French, this is a waste of time and results in low quality work which is often incomprehensible.
