This course is intended to give an introductory look at microeconomics topics. We will consider topics such as duality in consumer theory, Slutsky equation, consumer's surplus, general equilibrium, market and public policy (externalities, public goods), uncertainty, imperfect competition.

This course will provide students with a deeper understanding of fundamental concepts of microeconomics analysis.

This course will include some basic calculus material, as taught in Microeconomics 2.
