has/is having (to have) symptoms of intense stomach pain.

Jenny: "When did the pain start (pain/to start)?"

Mr. S. "I had (to have) a shooting pain this  
morning when I got (to get) out of bed this  
morning."

J.: "Ok Mr. Smith. Everything seems (to seem) ok. How  
do you feel/are you feeling (to feel) now? From one to ten, how  
much pain do you have (to have)?"

Mr. S.: "Probably a five. But it was (to be) an 8 this  
morning."

J.: "Ok I am sending (to send) your results to the lab later  
this afternoon. You can get dressed (to get dressed) now."
