1. Clean linens are necessary to prevent infections, so we change the patients' **sheets** every day.
2. We raise the **head of the bed** when we brush a patient's teeth so he does not choke.
3. Please put the patient's clothes in the **cabinet / wardrobe**.
4. **Bed rails** ensure that the patient does not fall out of bed.
5. The patient needs to defecate. Please give him the **bed pan** because he cannot leave his bed.
6. Mr. Smith is thirsty. Please put some water in the **glass / pitcher** and put it on his **tray table**.
